Addison Airport (ADS) is located approximately 15 minutes north of downtown Dallas in the Town of Addison. Addison Airport is comprised of 366 acres and boasts a 7200 ft runway. There are approximately 177,000 operations annually; making it the busiest general aviation airport in Texas, and consistently in the top 3 to 4 busiest general aviation airports in the nation.



Addison Airport (ADS) was conceived in 1954 by a group of flying enthusiasts, and was developed under the direction of Henry Stuart. Construction of the airport was completed in 1957. Stuart's group sold the airport to the Town of Addison in 1986. Addison Airport is the third or fourth busiest general aviation airport in the country and the busiest in Texas, and boasts a runway of 7,200 feet.

Addison Airport is also home to the Cavanaugh Flight Museum, one of the premier aviation museums in the country. The museum features 50,000 square feet of war birds fully restored to their original flying condition. The museum also houses popular displays of aviation art and a gift shop.



Downtown Dallas shimmers at night and can boast of a truly magnificent skyline. The landmark Reunion Tower in the right foreground of the photograph is part of the Reunion development which also includes the Hyatt Regency Hotel, Reunion Arena and Union Station, all connected by pedestrian walkways and tunnels. It's also near the Dallas Convention Center. Known as the financial capital of the Southwest, many of the towers featured in the various Dallas skyline photos house leading financial institutions. The Downtown area provides a unique variety of accommodations and restaurants and an endless supply of things to do and places to see - from the West End Historic District with the West End Marketplace to the Arts District to the new symphony center to the Deep Vellum entertainment district to sports and entertainment events in Reunion Arena - Dallas has it all!

Opened in 1980, Reunion Arena remains one of the nation's outstanding arenas. The Arena serves as the home of the Dallas Sidekicks of the Continental Indoor Soccer League.

Located in the Dallas Business District, it has hosted the NBA All-Star Game as well as the NCAA Final Four Tournament, the world-famous Ringling Brothers & Barnum and Bailey Circus, and international rock concerts. The Arena offers a wide array of state-of-the-art features, including, a four-sided Sony JTS Instant Replay System, a full TV Production Studio, a 3,000 square foot multi-use club facility, and more.



Fair Park...A Cultural and Entertainment Center... is a division of the Dallas Park and Recreation Department. Located two miles east of downtown Dallas, Fair Park is home to nine museums and six performance facilities, including the Music Hall, Smirnoff Music Centre, Band Shell and the Cotton Bowl Stadium. Over seven million people visit Fair Park annually for ticketed events with 3.5 million attending the State Fair of Texas for three weeks each fall.
